CAMP PURPOSE:



Asbury Camp does not carry any medical insurance on campers or staff. Parents, campers, staff, and guardians acknowledge that they are solely responsible for all medical and/or any other costs arising out of any bodily injury, illness or accident. Campers and staff are

voluntarily participating in the activities of Asbury Camp.

Every camper is expected to respect the camping facility, the staff and the rules by which the camp is governed.

All campers are expected to stay the entire week, Sunday through Saturday. Parents may not remove a camper from the camp without notifying the Camp Dean.

All campers are expected to participate in the full camp program and activities including camp clean-up.

No camper will be allowed off the campgrounds unless an emergency exists. Phone calls to campers during the week are discouraged unless an emergency exists.
